Copyright of images.

The Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 states that you fall in breach of the copyright act, if you use protect work under the following (digital) contexts.

“Artistic works.

(1)In this Part “artistic work” means—

- (a)a graphic work, photograph, sculpture or collage, irrespective of artistic quality,
- (b)a work of architecture being a building or a model for a building, or
- (c)a work of artistic craftsmanship.

(2)In this Part—

“building” includes any fixed structure, and a part of a building or fixed structure;

“graphic work” includes—

- (a)any painting, drawing, diagram, map, chart or plan, and
- (b)any engraving, etching, lithograph, woodcut or similar work;

“photograph” means a recording of light or other radiation on any medium on which an image is produced or from which an image may by any means be produced, and which is not part of a film;

“sculpture” includes a cast or model made for purposes of sculpture.”
